



Fees Rules:-

- (1) Fees are payable in advance before the 10th of any month, fees are charged for all months of the year.

Winter Session :-

Nursery to 7th - Coffee colour School Sweater. 8th to 12th-Coffee colour School Blazers.

GENERAL RULES:-

- (1) A pupil must have 75% attendance to be eligible for promotion. In case of Continuous absence for more than a week at a time. A vaild medical certificate from competent doctors must be produced along with a leave application parents / guardians.
- (2) Continued absence for 15 consecutive days without pre-intimation to school will result in the child's name being struck off the rolls without intimation to the parents.
- (3) Jewellery and costly ornaments are not to be worn/brought by the students. The school takes no etc. inside the school compus. The small children bring only non sticky eatables in their tiffin boxes.
- (4) Students will not be allowed to leave the school premises during school hours. However under emergent circumstances, permission my be granted by the Director/Principal only.
- (5) The school diary and note books must be checked by the parents every day and action should be taken there of.
- (6) No pupil will be permitted to appear at the Annual Examination unless all the dues are cleared by him/ her. Parents/Students will be held responsible for non-compliance of this Instruction.
- (7) Parents Teachers Meeting (PTM) will be held after every test/examination on the date & timing given in the school calendar. Parents are requested and advised to attend such meeting. The answer papers & the report cards kept in the individual folders of the students will be made available to parents on the meeting days.
- (8) Parents/guardians are advised to meet the teachers and if required Headmistress, Principal & Director also on meeting days and discuss about the achievements of their children. The exchange of suggestions will be a welcome move in the larger interest of the pupils & the institution.
- (9) Students are to pay for any damage to school property whether intentional or accidental.

- (10) Parents are requested to be vigilant about the personal cleanliness and hygiene of their children at home and before they proceed to school every day.
- (11) Parents are expected to maintain close liaison with the school to ascertain regularity, punctuality, conduct and academic progress of their wards & meeting concerned officials for suitable action.
- (12) For any queries, Director / Principal / Headmistress may be consulted forthwith.

Conduct:-

If a Student is found with unmanageable habits his / her name will be cut off from the roll of the school if done by the student will be compensated by his / her parents.

Withdrawal of students:-

If the parents/guardians wish to withdraw their children from the school they should apply in writing for the transfer certificate in the prescribed form available by the school.

Transfer certificate or any other certificates will be issued only after all the dues have been paid T.C. is issued generally fifteen days after submitting the application.

Responsibility of the school:-

The school does hold any responsibility for the loss of books stationary, money or any valuable things of a student during the school time or on way to school or home.

However parents and requested to keep a to check to their child that they should not carry the valuable things to the school.
